

# Rockford Wins Tri-River Title

Rockford High received two big first place efforts by Leon Schab and a record heave in the shotput by Drake Knapp to overcome Comstock Park and win the Tri-River dual track championship Wednesday night at Lowell.

Schab's victories in the 100 and 200-yard dashes and Knapp's toss of 50 feet 11 inches overcame Comstock Park's strength in the relays for a 54-45 triumph. Clarence Buschert also was a double winner for Rockford.

Rockford had an assist from Sparta, however, as the Spartans dumped Lowell 68½-40½ which dropped Lowell out of a first-place tie with the new league champs.

In the other night's action at Lowell, Cedar Springs defeated Belding 64-44.

In addition to Knapp's record, Judd Ring of Sparta set a new mark in the mile run with a 4:46.2

and Dan Carr of Belding broke the 180 hurdles mark with a time of :22.5.
