

# Vicksburg in Setback at South Haven

## Balance of Rams Key to Victory

SOUTH HAVEN — South Havens balance made the difference here Wednesday afternoon as the Rams measured Vicksburg, 65-44, in a prep dual track and field meet.

Although coach Tom Horns Vicksburg squad had double winners in Bob Pursel (high jump and low hurdles) and Bob Bishop (100 and 220 yard dashes) South Haven picked up its third Wolverine Conference win in four tries.

Coach Ron DenUyls Rams won both relays and six different men won individual events. Broad jumper Aaron McIntosh and pole vault Tom Claflin did not compete for South Haven Wednesday because of injuries.
