# Pennfield's Gary Rugg Sets Class B Shot Mark

EAST LANSING—Gary Rugg, Pennfield High's powerful shot-putter tossed the 12-pound iron ball farther than anyone in all four classes of the state track meets around the state yesterday when he set a new record with a heave of 55 feet, 8½ inches. It was a foot better than the former mark held by Earl Glenn of Rockford set in 1953.

It was the only record set in the field events of the Class B trials here.

Willie Betts of River Rouge was the only double winner, taking both the 120 yard high hurdles and the 180 lows. His time in the highs of :14.9 tied the existing record of :14.9 by Dave Hill of Ypsilanti in 1949. Dave McLaughlin of Chelsea, who placed second in the final, bettered the record in the morning preliminaries with :14.8 but

Betts took the 180 yard low hurdles in :20.3, no record.

Moss Easley of Dowagiac was the 220 yard dash winner for Dowagiac with a time of :22.6. The final running event, the mile relay in a time tie between River Rouge and Detroit St. Joseph at 3:32.9, also tying the state record set last year by East Grand Rapids.
