Dowagiac Wins Track Title

Watt's joy couldn't be concealed Saturday following Dowaglac High's Class B track meet triumph at Michigan State University.

The victory climaxed a perfect first season for Watt, 24, who graduated from Hope College last June. He played football but never ran track, It was Dowagiae's first state crown since 1934 along with winning the Big Six Conference for the first time in 16 vears.
