

# Ferndale Thinclad in Two Marks at Albion

ALBION — (UPI) — Dorie Reed, Spring Ferndale High senior, set two new Albion College Class A high school track meet records Saturday, although his teammates finished second behind Champion Monroe.

Reed ran the 100-yard dash in 9.7 seconds and the 220-yard dash in 22.25 seconds to establish new records.

Monroe won the Class A team title with 56 points, followed by Ferndale, 34½; Jackson 33 5/6; Lansing Everett 26 1/3, and Ann Arbor 21.

Clio won the Class B championship with 38 points. Sturgis was second with 34¾ and Grosse Ile third with 31.

The Class C crown was carried home by Battle Creek Springfield which collected 38¾ points. East Jackson was second with 30¾ and Grass Lake third with 20½.

Covert won the Class D trophy with 60 1/5 points. Custer-Eastern was second with 29 1/5 and Litchfield third with 28 7/10.

Other meet records were set by Walt Worthy of Kalamazoo Central in the broad jump with a leap of 22 feet, 2½ inches; Larry Page of Monroe in the 440-yard run, with a time of 50.35 seconds, both in Class A.

Dave Loomis of East Jackson set a Class C 100-yard dash record, timed in 10 seconds flat and Mike Rocca of Battle Creek Springfield won the Class C broad jump going 21 feet, 2 inches.
