## Relay Win to Flint Central

## Bay City Entries Tie for 5th Place

SAGINAW — Flint Central took five first places, came through with important seconds and thirds in key events and broke two meet records to edge; out Flint Northern in the fourth anual Arthur Hill Relays held at Arthur Hill Track here yesterday afternoon.

The Indians scored 64 points as Northern had 61 for a close second place finish. Northern won the meet in the first two

years of its running, 1959 and
