Pontiac Winner in Detroit Run

DETROIT — (AP) — Pontiac Central, winning four of the 12 events, took Class A honors in the sixth annual University of Detroit high school relays Saturday.

Ecorse, a perennial track power, won in Class B and U-D High School took first place honors in a new division, Class S, for Parochial and private schools.

Athletes from a total of 56 schools took part in the meet. seven new team marks were established, two by Pontiac, in the shuttle hurdle relay and broad jump, and three by Ecorse, in the distance medley relay, pole vault and high jump.

Detroit Mumford set new mark of 3:26.8 in the mile relay and Detroit Cody established a record 18:36.4 in the four-mile relay.

In Class A, Pontiac Central compiled 27½ points to finish ahead of Mumford, with 22 and Romulus, with 18. Others were Detroit Northwestern and Detroit Redford, tied for fourth with 17 each.

Ecorse swept to its Class B! victory with 51 points, chiefly on the strength of its record performances. Lutheran West was second with 43. Romeo a distant third with 23, and River Rouge fourth with 21. Clintondale finished fifth with 13.

In Class S, U-D High School garnered 46 points to win handily over Detroit DeLaSalle with 33½ and Detroit Catholic Central, with 311/2. Detroit Servite was fourth with 19 and Detroit St. Joseph fifth with 17.
