Thirty years of service in the public schools of Michigan began as an elementary and high school teacher, then superintendent of schools in Tustin, Onaway, and Roseville, Michigan; prior to coming to Southfield in 1947.

Mr. Schoenhals received his Bachelor of Arts Degree from Michigan State Normal College in 1924. He was a recipient of a Master of Arts Degree in School of Education, University of Michigan. Also, additional graduate work was taken at Western Michigan University and Wayne State University.

His attitude toward life and his administrative capacities were unusual. Education lost a friend and an outstanding educator. His passing on March 7, 1962, was a great loss to all.
