Francie Kraker, John Gregg, and Pole Vaulters Rod Denhart and Steve Overton added victories in last night's meet here.

Youthful Miss Kraker won the 440-yard dash in 1:04 flat, her fourth straight triumph, and added a second place in her first try at 100 yards; Gregg romped home first in the Senior century, and Denhart and Overton tied for first in the vault at 13 feet 8½ inches.

Meanwhile, Pete Olmstead (2:09.6) was fourth in the Junior 880 and the mile-relay team of Jim Burger, Len Joeris, Gregg, and Angus MacDougali also finished fourth.
