

# Cubs Score Points in All Events

### Catholic Kings Win St. Joseph Relays

U-D High, intent upon a successful defense of its Catholic League track title next month, swept to an easy victory Sunday in the St. Joseph Relays at U-D Stadium.

The Cubs won four firsts, tied for a fifth and scored in all 12 events for an 81-point total.

Catholic Central finished second with 69 points, followed by DeLaSalle 56, St. Joseph 54, Brother Rice 48, Cathedral Central 26 and Notre Dame 24.

ACTUALLY, three milers put on the day's top performances.

Norm Koltys of Brother Rice and Dick Doherty of DeLaSalle duelled it out on the final mile lap of the distance medley.

Koltys, a junior, beat Doherty with a sprint in the final 50 yards to win by half a stride in 4:35. Doherty's time was 4:31.1.

Then U-D's Dick Reamer, who many think is the league's best miler, turned in a 4:36.8 clocking in helping the Cubs win the four-mile event in 19 minutes, 29.8 seconds.

U-D coach John Tenbusch also got a fine shotput effort from Tom Nowoswicz who tossed the ball 91 feet 10 1/2 inches.

St. Joseph's 880-yard relay team of Jerome Patton, John White, Ted Chmura and Ron Fern turned in a 1:32.8 effort, a second and a half better than the existing league mark of 1:34.1 owned by DeLaSalle.

### Last Is Best

Tom Albers won the broad jump, final event of the day, to give St. Ambrose High a 55-54 track victory over Sacred Heart Sunday at Derby High.

Peter Conrad won both the 100 and 220-yard dashes for the Cavaliers and anchored the winning 880-yard relay team.

### Hurls Shot 51 Feet

Servite High won both the 100 medley relay (2:44) and two-mile relay (8:34) and piled up 64 points Sunday to win the third annual Orchard Lake St. Mary invitational track meet on Sunday.

Servite won with 64 points, followed by Holy Redeemer 53, Orchard Lake St. Mary 45, St. Alphonsus 44, Benedictine 40, St. Anthony 26, Saginaw SS 16, Our Lady of Sorrows 10 and St. Stanislaus 4.

Although his team finished fourth in the event, Benedictine's Joe Feroch threw the shot 51 feet 3 inches for the day's top individual performance.

## 'I Didn't Record, F

Young Brian Sternberg, who 5 inches broke the world record doesn't count.

"Listen, I'll bet I couldn't do 15 feet with metal," he said after his record vault in the Penn Relays Saturday.

"I really didn't break the record—Don Bragg still holds the real record with a metal pole."

THE 19-YEAR-OLD sophomore from the University of Washington, who had never gone over 16 feet in an outdoor meet before, used a fiberglass pole in his record vault.

"If they're going to use fiberglass, I want to be the best," he said, then pointed again to Bragg as the holder of the "real" record.

Bragg, a former Villanova star, held a previous record, less than 16 feet, set with a metal pole. All vaults over 16 feet have been made with fiberglass.

Sternberg's record was one of three world marks shattered Saturday, and another was bettered but won't be allowed because of wind.

AL OBERTEK of New York broke his own discus record and a quartet from Arizona State at Tempe lowered the mile relay record in the Mt.

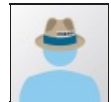
