# Injuries Dim Track Hopes

**By JIM HIGGINBOTTOM** EAST LANSING, May 25.—Injuries have hit several of Michigan's best high school track and field stars, and the fact that one in particular has been slowed will directly effect today's state Class. A title picture.

A leg muscle which has bothered crack sprinter Dalton Kimble most of the season could erase all championship hopes of perennial contender Flint Northern, competing with the other big school teams here at Michigan State's Ralph Young Field.

Class B squads are running at the University of Michigan.

Central Michigan University hosts a combined C-D meet. All Upper Peninsula teams, regardless of class, are at Northern Michigan.

Kimble, a pre-season favorite in both the 100 and 220. will run only a relay leg. Teammates Wilbut Johnson and Willie Buck must shoulder Northern's burden in the dashes.

Kimble's absence from the individual events is almost sure to rob the Flint team of valuable points. Johnson, however, figures to be somewhere near the front.

Willie Jones, of Monroe; John Bryant, of Mumford; Matt Jackson, of Chadsey; Orville Mullins, of Kettering: Walt Worthy, of Kalamazoo Central, and Tom Muses, of Northwestern, also are contenders in the dash field.

Interest will be centered again on the mile run, where little Lou Scott, of Eastern, goes after his own 4:17.4 record. The high jump shapes up as a battle between Al Washington, Flint Northern's best first-place hope, and Ann Arbor's Ken Dyer.

The track and field stars will be shooting for more than first places in today's meet. The News is selecting an All-State team in the sport for the first time this year and outstanding performances are the key to selection.

The All-State will be an-. nounced June 8, the Saturday following the Detroit Public School League meet, which is June 6.


