

Scoring Crown Goes to Brown

Ottawa Ace Adds Individual Track Title to Cage Feat

Ottawa Hills' Fred Brown is the 1963 City League track scoring champion with 105 $\frac{3}{4}$ points.

Fred McKee finished in the runnerup position for the second straight year on 102 7-12 points and South's Obie Walker took third with 97 $\frac{1}{2}$.

The track title is the second scoring championship won by the standout Ottawa athlete this year. He finished in the No. 1 spot in the City League basketball race.

Brown was unbeaten in both hurdles this year in dual and city meet competition. He chalked up 40 points in the low hurdles and 35 in the highs. He was injured the first part of the season and didn't compete in the two hurdle events in the opening meet against Union.

Brown's 15.5 seconds for the high hurdles in the state meet was tops for the local athletes. However, he didn't place in the qualifying rounds at the state meet last Saturday. Brown also held the best time in the city for low hurdles with a 20.8.

Besides hurdling, Brown tossed the 12-pound shotput and tallied 29 points.

Four-Event Athlete

McKee, who finished second behind Ottawa's Dick Wells in the 1962 race, took part in the high jump, broad jump, low hurdles and the sprints, along with being

a member of the 880 relay.

The Union High senior picked up 31 points in the low hurdles, 30 1-3 in the high jump and 26 in the broad jump.

Two Central High athletes, Rocky Rosema and Larry Goodson, placed fourth and fifth, respectively. Rosema ended with 82 $\frac{1}{4}$ and Goodson 77 $\frac{1}{4}$.

Goodson competed in the sprints and 880 relay for the Rams. His 10.2 for the 100 in last Saturday's state meet was the lowest clocking for the event in the city this year.

Rosema, a junior and all-state football tackle last fall, took part in the shotput, broad jump, 440 and mile relay.

Aside from Catholic Central's Mike Neuman, Grand Rapids failed to win a point in the state finals at East Lansing. Neuman gained five points for third place in the shotput in the state meet. He finished with 50 points in the event, but failed to place among the top 10 scorers. He competed only in the shotput.
