3 TRACK CHAMPS CROWNED

Preps Break Records

U-D High, Benedictine and Brother Rice earned Catholic League divisional track titles Thursday in nine hours of almost continual competition at Pershing High.

The meet qualified the best of 450 entrants for the Catholic League championships scheduled June 8. U-D High fought off Catho-

lic Central for the Central Division crown, 49-39. Benedictine narrowly nipped Holy Redeemer, 45 1/2-44 1/2, in the Double A.A. division.

BROTHER RICE, the new school from Birmingham, overwhelmed runner-up St. Alphonsus, 83-33, for the A Division crown.

Records were set in all running events except the 100-yard dash.

The day's top efforts were turned in by Frank Haggerty, Catholic Central high hurdler, who recorded a 151.1 clocking, and by U-D High's Dick Reamer, who turned in a 4:32.8 mile.
