# Pershing Wins City Track Crown

Carl Holmes, who helped open his school 33 years ago, had to grab twice for a trophy he almost dropped Thursday as his Pershing High track team won its first City League title in six years.

Happy and proud, the Ot coach rode the shoulders of a husky shotputter halfway across the football field. It was his field event men, and a junior hurdler, who made this day possible.

Pershing placed 1-5 in the

shot, 1-4 in the broad jump and 2-5 in the high jump. That gave the Doughboys a running start of 55½ points.

When Bernie Cage, a hurdler who said "I'll win 'em both for the coach," did just that it was all over. Cage turned in a sizzling 19.3 winning effort in the low hurdles but couldn't be credited with a record effort due to a brisk tailwind.

Pershing rolled up 57½ points, with all but one of

these points coming in the first eight events, and then defied the rest of the field to catch up. No team could.

The day's lone record belonged to Lou Scott, the phenomenal little senior who may be remembered for many years as the greatest distance runner the league has ever produced.

Scott set the mile record of 4:13.2 last year. This spring he went after the half mile mark and got it Thursday when he came breezing home in 1:34.3 bettering

Terry Moore's previous mark of 1:55 flat.

The day's other top performance belonged to Art Link, of Redford, who led all the way in posting a 4:20.9 mile.

In addition to Cage other Pershing winners were Nate Hawkins with a heave of 55 feet, 1 inch in the shot put and Willie Iverson who won the broad jump at 22 feet, 2½ inches.

John Bryant, of Mumford, captured the 220-yard dash

in :21.3 after being "photod out" in the 100 when four rivals hit the tape in a virtual dead heat.
