

WIN TRACK TITLE

Shamrocks Edge U-D High by One

Catholic Central set a record Saturday in winning the mile relay to dethrone U-D High by one point in the Catholic League track championships at Pershing Field.

Bill Abele, Mark Sweeney and the Rymysza brothers, Jim and Mike, ran the mile in 3:35.5 to lower the league record from 3:38.7 held by Notre Dame.

Frank Haggerty won the 120-yard high hurdles and Dennis Voytovich cleared 11 feet, 8 inches in the pole vault for other Shamrock firsts.

DICK REAMER broke his own mile mark of 4:32.8 as he ran 4:29.4 to lead U-D's futile chase.

Four other records fell as more than 200 athletes competed in the 13 events.

Joe Pavelich set a shot put mark with a heave of 54 feet, 8 inches. Cathedral's Bill Brown ran the 440 in :51.9. Pat Fulford of Notre Dame, the lone double winner, ran the 100 in 10.1 and took the 220.

Cathedral's relay team set the other mark as they flashed through the 880 in 1:33.8.

In the team standings, CC had 38 and U-D High 37. Benedictine finished third with 17 points followed by Cathedral 16½, DeLaSalle 15½, Notre Dame 15, St. Joseph 14, Brother Rice 13, Servite 11, Holy Redeemer 10, Dearborn Sacred Heart 5 and Shrine 3.
