

Three Brothers Win

ANN ARBOR (UPI)—The Littlejohns dominated the second Michigan Track meet at Ferry Field Wednesday.

A total of 13 clubs with 91 athletes entered the meet but the three Littlejohn brothers who were competing unattached dominated the afternoon.

Alonzo, a former Western Michigan University track star, won the high jump with a leap of 6-feet-4 while his brother Jim who is a sophomore at Western came in second at 6-feet-2.

Their kid brother Dale who is still in high school won the high

jump in the junior class with a leap of 6-feet.

Art Link of Detroit Redford High School who ran unattached took both the mile and two mile runs in the junior class.

George Hoey of the Flint track club won both the broad jump and 220-yard dash in the junior division.

John Gregg of the Ann Arbor track club won both the dashes in the senior classes while Steve Leuchtman, who was competing unattached won the shot put and discus.

Francie Kraker of the Ann Arbor track club won the two women's dashes.
