Chris McCarthy of Chicago is the new national AAU 50kilometer (31 miles) road running champion.

McCarthy bested a field of 11 other finishers Saturday in a Freedom Festival event which started at the City-County building and ended at the Detroit Boat Club after five whirles around Belle Isle.
