

Track Records Fall At Fieldhouse

The record book was being rewritten today for the Michigan Federation Championships.

Seven meet records were broken and two were tied in the fourth annual meet at Yost Fieldhouse yesterday. In addition, the second best 880-yard run in the history of the fieldhouse was turned in. Four of the records were set by Coach Don Canham's Michigan thin-clads and the two which were tied were by Wolverines.

Lanky, red-headed Michigan senior, Ted Kelly, turned in the sparkling 880 with a 1:53. Only Pete Gray's 1:42.8 in 1955 is better. A qualifier was necessary in the afternoon and Kelly earned the No. 1 lane with a 1:58.9.

Meet records fell to Kelly, Daswell Campbell of East Lansing in the 440-yard run, Roger Schmitt of Michigan in the shot put, Kent Bernard of Michigan in the 600-yard run, Jim Albrecht of Northwestern in the pole vault and Michigan in the university mile relay. A meet record fell to high school miler Ken Coates of Wyoming Park. Coates' time of 4:26.9 also was the best time for a prepster in Yost.

Meet records were tied by Michigan's Cliff Nuttall in the 65-yard high hurdles and Michigan's Dorie Reid in the 60-yard dash.

Ann Arbor's Francie Kraker, representing the Ann Arbor Anns, won the women's 440-yard run against a tough field of Ecorse racers.
