## Pioneers Outpoint Central Trackmen

ANN ARBOR—The Pioneers of Ann Arbor High piled up a 29-7 advantage in the four field events here last night and went on from there to defeat Battle Creek Central in a Six-A track and field meet, 71-38.

Ann Arbor had too much depth for the Bearcats in scoring their fourth straight victory after an opening loss to powerful Flint Southwestern.

The Bearcats won five of the last eight running events but by that time the home forces were too far in front.

Joe Reno of Battle Creek turned in one of the best performances in capturing the 880 in 2:00.7, considered excellent on the soggy track. Heavy rains on Monday left the track in poor condition.

Dick Speights took both hurdles for Central, the high sticks in :15.0 and low barriers in :22.2 while teammate Arnie Williams breezed home first in the two sprints, the 100 in :10.1 and 220 in :22.2.
