

## Flint Takes Indoor Meet, Oilers Shine

MOUNT PLEASANT (AP)—A runnerup for three straight years, Flint Central finally clinched the top spot in Central Michigan University's Class A Indoor Invitational Friday night.

Central had two first places and scored in nine of 12 events in the 13th annual running of the high school track competition.

The Indians collected 35 points, two more than runnerup Pontiac Central. Midland was third with 21 points, followed by Mount Pleasant with 20.

Defending champion Flint Northern — winner for three straight years and five out of the last six—finished fifth with 16 points.

Flint Central's Bob Cooper won the 60-yard dash in 6.3 seconds, and teammate Archey Pearson took the 65-yard low hurdles in :07.4.

Mount Pleasant, Midland and Lansing Eastern, which finished eighth with 10 points, each scored double victories.

Mount Pleasant's Lynn Smith won the 440-yard dash in 54 seconds, and teammate Gale Neff clinched the 880-yard run in 2:04.2.

Midland's victories were in the shot put and 65-yard high hurdles. Steve Dowling's winning leap was 52 feet, 3½ inches, while Al Payne was clocked in 0:54.

A Lansing Eastern team took the medley relay with a 6:09.3 clocking, and Eastern's Daryle Burt captured the mile in 4:15.6.
