

Colt Bill Crawford In 6-4 Relay Jump

EAST LANSING—Flint Southwestern's Bill Crawford with a second-place leap in the high jump was Flint's highest finisher in the first annual Michigan State-Lansing State Journal Relays here Saturday.

Ann Arbor copped the team championship with 25 points, nine in front of runnerup Lansing Sexton. Birmingham Seaholm, Huron Relays winner two weeks ago, tied Romulus for third position with 12 points.

Crawford matched the 6-4 jump of Ann Arbor's Ken Dyer but had one more miss than the winner.

Grand Blanc's Ed Clark, Big Nine Conference shotput champion, took fourth with a 49-7/8 effort.

The team fight was a tight one as 66 schools competed before a crowd of 3,011 in MSU's Jenison Field House. Eight schools picked up the 12 first place spots.
