

**Set Four Records**

**Central Trackmen Whip Eastern, 76-33**

Central High's track team set four records and tied another in running up a 76-33 triumph over Lansing Eastern last night at the C. W. Post Field track.

Joe Reno, plucky half-miler, set new standards in the 880-yard run for both the C. W. Post track and for the school. Arnie Williams set a new track mark in the 220-yard dash while tying the varsity time and the Bearcat 880-yard relay team also established a new school standard.

Reno, who only recently lowered the school mark to 1:57.8, covered the half-mile last night in one minute, 36.5 seconds to cut even more time off the varsity standard. He also beat his old track mark of 1:59.4 set earlier this year.

Williams covered the 220 in 21.7 seconds to beat the old track mark of 22 seconds held by himself and Dick Allen of Lansing Sexton. It also tied the school mark held by Jim Burise in 1960.

The half-mile relay team of Dick Speights, Tom Hodges, Carl English and Williams stepped off the distance in one minute and 30 seconds to beat the old mark of 1:30.5 set in 1960 by Joe Bass, Jeff Nelson, Leroy Tisdell and Burise. According to Coach Jack Finn, this is the best time posted by an 880 relay team in the state this spring.

The meet was all Central. The Bearcats captured eight first places besides the 880 relay. Central ran up a 27-9 lead in the field events and held a 49-24 edge in the running races.

Pete Jenny led a Central sweep in the pole vault when he cleared 10 feet, six inches and Woody Carr won the high jump with Fred Jones second.

Dick Speights led the sweep in the high hurdles in 14.8 seconds followed by Ken Richardson and Henry Braddock. Speights led the 1-2-3 finish in the low barriers followed by Braddock and Charles Dismuke.

Tom Hodges followed Williams across the finish line in both dashes as Williams was timed in :09.9 seconds in the century. Central's other first came in the broad jump where Larry Wadsworth made 19 feet, 11½ inches.

The final mile relay was the most thrilling race of the night as Reno anchored the Bearcats and was 10 yards behind. He just missed taking up the slack and was an inch or so behind at the finish. Joe was timed in the remarkable time of 50 seconds flat for the quarter-mile.

It was Central's fifth dual victory in six meets this season.
