Ken Dyer Leaps 6-7

YPSILANTI — Ken Dyer of Ann Arbor High stole the Class A regional track and field meet show here yesterday by clearing 6 feet, 7 $\frac{1}{8}$ inches, to win the high jump.

His leap surpassed the state A record of 6-5 by Al Washington of Flint Northern in 1963 but Dyer must pass the mark in the state finals to get into the record books. The national prep record is 6 feet, 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches, by Walter Mangham of New Castle, Ind., in 1956.

Ypsilanti Central won the A regional team title on 32 points while Ann Arbor was second at 26. Jackson Parkside finished eighth with 13 tallies while Jackson had 9.
