Jackson's Dell Littejohn cleared stx-feet, 31 inches in the high jump to the the mark set last year by Ann Arbor's Ken Doyen.

Ken Boushka of Adrian was the only double-winner in Class A. He won the 100-yard dash in 10.2, and came back to take the 220 in 22.6.
