

# Smash 11 Records In Central Relays

MOUNT PLEASANT (AP) — Birmingham Seaholm outdued Lansing Sexton and Flint Central for the Class A championship and Battle Creek St. Phillip put on a strong finish to take the Class C title Saturday in the 24th annual Central Michigan Relays.

River Rouge won in Class B

and Pickford copped the Class D title Friday.

Birmingham Seaholm scored in 10 of 16 events in posting 62 points in the meet which saw new records set in 11 of the 32 events. Two other records were tied.

Lansing Sexton finished with

54 points and Flint Central had 50.

In the ever-close Class C section, St. Phillip scored only 39 points but won the final event and held off a series of challenges by Portland and Flint Holy Redeemer.

The oldest Class C record went by the boards when Cheboygan Catholic Central's Lou Fournier threw the 12-pound shot 53 feet 9 1/2 inches to shatter the mark of 52' 8" set by Tom Koczman of Milan in 1947.

Seaholm bettered by almost 11 seconds the middle distance relay mark when it was clocked in 5:44.2, compared to the 5:55 record set by Detroit Thurston in 1962.

St. Phillip broke two of the three team records set in Class C when it won in 2:31.8 in the sprint medley relay and in 1:33.9 in the 880-yard relay.

It tied another mark in the 440-yard relay with a time of :45.7 seconds.

Dion Stewart of East Lansing outlasted Birmingham Seaholm's Scott Bradley and won the Class A mile in 4:27.6 for another record. Bradley finished in 4:28, also bettering the old mark.

Howell came in first in the two-mile relay in 8:13.1; Roseville was timed in 2:29.8 in the sprint medley relay; Farmington won the mile relay in 3:28.2 and Seaholm took the 880-yard relay in 1:13.7 in other Class A record performances.

Jim Havilland of Waterford Kettering set an individual record when he cleared the bar at 13 feet, 1 1/2 inches in the Class A pole vault.

Flint St. John Vianney broke the Class C two-mile relay record with a time of 8:35.9.
