

Teutons Grab Catholic Loop Track Crown

St. Anthony High won two first places outright and tied for a third to easily win the Catholic League's AA track and field title at Henry Ford High.

The Teutons piled up 56 points followed by Benedictine 33, Divine Child 26, Shrine 23, Servite 20, Holy Redeemer 16, Redford St. Mary 13 and St. Andrew 2.

Rock Rosal won the shotput for St. Anthony with a heave of 60 feet, 9 inches. Gary Jeromin took the 440 in :32.4.

Jim Seymour of Shrine won both hurdles, placed second in the broad jump and fifth in the shotput. Roger Flaherty won both dashes for Benedictine.

St. Joseph Romps

Capturing six firsts and scoring in 11 of 13 events, St. Joseph High won the East-West division Catholic League track title Wednesday at Pershing High.

The Blue Jays piled up 66 points and were followed by Roosevelt Sacred Heart 34½, St. Patrick 27, St. David 26½, St. Alphonsus 16, Dearborn Sacred Heart 16 and St. Francis Cabrini 2.

Double winners for St. Joseph were Pat Dudley in the shotput and low hurdles and Jerry Fatten in the high jump and 100-yard dash. The Fradette twins, John and Mike, of St. Joseph, finished 1-2 in the mile, John winning in 4:34.4.

Thurston Posts 5th Track Title

Thurston High won its fifth straight conference track title, but first as a member of the Northwest Suburban League by overpowering four other foes Wednesday. Thurston scored 77½ points to runnerup Birmingham Groves' 61.

Sophomore Al Phillips won the high jump for Thurston at 6-3 and miler Keith Reed turned in a 4:26.6 performance.

Ecorse Runners Fastest in League

Ecorse High won six first places Wednesday to run off with the Twin Valley conference track title with 71½ points.

Following Ecorse were: River Rouge 57, Romulus 50, Willow Run 29½ and Hamtramck 3. Records were set by Al Lackey of Ecorse, who turned in a 4:20.9 mile and by Doug Montgomery, of Romulus, who won the high hurdles in :14.3 seconds.
