

## Allegan Trackmen Finish In 3rd Place In Conference Meet

Allegan's 880 relay team smashed the Wolverine League and Allegan High School record last Thursday night in the conference meet at Portage with a fine 1:32.8 clocking.

The previous school mark of 1:34.4 was set in 1933 by Red Conlee, George Humm, Harold Bussey and Charles Smith. The league record set by U-High in 1962 had been 1:34.0.

The Tiger quartet is made up of Terry Loll, Jeff Schreur and Dave Hagger, all juniors, and Mickey Jorgens, a sophomore.

Allegan's only other first place in the conference meet, in which they finished a surprising third, was by Jim Pritchett another sophomore, who threw the shot 48'8".

Three other loop marks were broken: Jim Giachino of U-High ran the half-mile in 1:58.5; Jim Cunningham of South Haven pole vaulted 12'8"; Doug Springer, Vicksburg, high jumped 6'2 1/4".

Other second places going to Allegan were: Ted Lange in the low hurdles; Mickey Jorgens in the 100 yard dash; Dave Hagger, 220 yard dash; and the mile relay team composed of Tim Wilcox, Jorgens, Hagger and Paul Grewe. Dennis Stora took third in the 440 yard dash.

Hagger in the 100, Grewe in the half-mile and Loll in the 220 scored with fifths.

Allegan's freshman 440 relay team placed second behind Plainwell.
