

Ypsi Wins Track Title

Ypsilanti High streaked to the Huron-Rouge Valley Conference track and field championship Wednesday, edging Dearborn in a struggle that produced six conference records.

Homer Hinchcliff won the high jump at 5-11 and the pole vault at a record 12-2 $\frac{3}{4}$ to lead Ypsilanti's 62-point surge.

Dearborn's Andy Martin swept the hurdles in record times of :14.6 for the highs and :19.5 for the lows, and won the broad jump at 20-8. On his triple, Dearborn amassed 53 points.

Other records fell to Dearborn's mile relay team, which won in 3:39.4, and Dearborn's Bob Sutherland and John Spain. Sutherland won the mile in 4:27.7 and Spain the 880 in 1:58.2.

Wayne was third in the team scramble with 33 points, followed by Ford 28, Lincoln Park 15 and Melvindale 6.
