HAYES JONES

Spirit, ambition, dedication, and determination - - these are just a few of the "sterling qualities" which have made Hayes Jones an outstanding figure in the track world.

As a Sophomore, competing for Pontiac Central High School, he qualified for the State Championships in the high hurdles. In his Junior year, he won the high hurdles, was second in the lows and third in the high jump. State records were set by him while winning the high hurdles and the broad jump in his Senior year, as well as winning the low hurdles, plus leading off the State champion 880 yard relay team. His record in the broad jump of 23 feet 8 7/8 inches is still listed on the record books. In addition to this, many other records were set by him in the large invitational meets throughout the State of Michigan and Ohio.

At Eastern Michigan University, he was the proverbial work-horse on the team, competing in as many as six events in a single meet. As an example of this, six first places were registered by him in one meet, when he won the 100, 220, high hurdles, low hurdles, high jump and broad jump.

In 1960, he was a member of the United States Olympic team and placed third in the high hurdles. Today he is the top contender for a gold medal in the Olympics to be held in Japan this fall.

On the National level, he has competed in the Pan-Americal Games, the dual meets with Russia and other European countries, and as a member of various touring teams, sent abroad by the United States.

His record on the indoor boards is astounding. Ho has won 55 straight indoor hurdle races. He holds world records at three distances, 50 yards, 60 yards and 70 yards and is the co-holder of the record at 45 yards. Of the 18 major indoor meets now being held annually, Hayes holds meet records in 13 of them and is the co-holder in the other five.

As great as his performances on the track have been, they are no greater than he is as an individual. He is a very terrific person and a gentleman who has represented his schools, his community and his Nation in the highest order of sportsmanship.

The athletes competing here today and their coaches are most happy to dedicate this program to Hayes Jones. We consider it a distinct honor that you and your family could join us on this day and we thank you for doing so. Sincerest best wishes for all of your endeavors in the future and may the best of all good things always come your way.
