

## Charlevoix Fourth in CMU Relays Saturday

Charlevoix high school returned from the Central Michigan Relays Saturday with fourth place including four first place showings in the annual event which was the 24th running.

Larry McBride took first in the pole vault with a mark of 12 feet-2¾ inches while Gary Stutzman won the low hurdles with a :21.3 time and took the high's at :15.7.

The Charlevoix shuttle hurdle relay team took the fourth first place with a time of 1:04.5. Members of this team included Andy Carey, Steve Wilson, Jim Ferguson and Gary Stutzman.

Kermit Ambrose has led his Birmingham Seaholm High School track team to practically every championship possible, except the coveted state title.

The Maples have never won the state crown during Ambrose's 12-year-reign, but are considered prime contenders for Class A honors this season after their strong showing Saturday in the 24th annual Central Michigan University relays.

Seaholm took Class A honors in the meet for the second straight year with 62 points. The Maples scored in 10 of the 16 events and

took three firsts and set two records.

Battle Creek St. Philip took Class C honors as 11 records were broken and two others tied.

Among the top individual efforts were a 59 feet, 9 inch shot put toss by Lou Fournier of Cheboygan Catholic; Waterford Kettering's Jim Haviland's 13 feet, 4¼ inch pole vault; Bob Richards' of Bloomfield Hills 1:55.5 unofficial time in the 880-yard run and the 4:27.6 mile by Dion Stewart of East Lansing.
