

St. Philip Relay Teams Run Well In Kazoo Meet

KALAMAZOO — St. Philip High's crack relay teams ran their best times yet but placed far down in their respective races in the Champion of Champions invitational track meet held here at Western Michigan University's Waldo Stadium yesterday.

The 880 relay combination of Dave Austin, Jim Bauman, Herb Tillman and Mike Poyer took a seventh in one minute, 32.4 seconds, beating their old mark by two-tenths of a second. But Roseville's crack quartet won the event in 1:29.9.

The mile relay team Tillman, Jim Cvetnich, Jon Cowles and Tony Jaskie was timed in 3:33.1 beating their old mark of 3:35.1 but had to settle for sixth as Roseville won the race in 3:22.0, the best time listed in the state this season.

Bauman took a sixth in the 440-yard dash being timed in :51.4 seconds.

One of the top performances of the meet was the 4:20.1 mile run by Jim Giachino of Kalamazoo University High.
