

Michigammes Win AAU Championship

The Southeastern Michigammes reigned as the state AAU cross country championship team today.

The Ann Arbor based team closed out an undefeated season Saturday at Rouge Park by sweeping to victory. Sperry Jones, a graduate student at Michigan, won the individual title and set a new course record as she toured the mile and one half course in 9:06, clipping four seconds off of the old record set by teammate Francie Kraker. Miss Kraker, a freshman at Michigan, placed second in 9:08 and Vonnie Perrine came in third in 9:18.

The Michigammes' Janie Shulte, 14, won the junior class championship and set a new course record of 6:08. The old record over the mile course was 6:18. Margie Marque placed seventh for the Michigammes. There is no team competition in the junior class.
