## 1965 FINAL CROSS COUNTRY RUN RESULTS

There were two Final Cross Country Runs this year. On October 16, the Upper Peninsula Final Cross Country Run was held at Northern Michigan University, Marquette, and the Lower Peninsula Final Cross Country Run was held at Eastern Michigan University, Ypsilanti, on November 6.

There were six Regional Cross Country Runs, each of Classes A and B. For the first time, the Class C-D schools were assigned to four Regional Runs from which they qualified to the Final Run.

At the Lower Peninsula Final Run the Class A team championship was won for the second consecutive year by Royal Oak-Kimball High School, with 63 points. Wyandotte-Roosevelt with 76 points. and Jackson-Parkside with 124 points. were second and third, respectively. Alphonse Ruffner of Wyandotte-Roosevelt was first-place finisher with a time of 10:06.9. Kenneth Leonowicz of Hazel Park was second and James Love of Flint-Central was third. There were 56 participants in the Class A Individuals Run. This run was won by Ivan Scholl of Roseville with a time of 9:59.9. Following the winner were Kimberly Hartman of Southfield and Jack Magelsson of Flint-Ainsworth.

The Team Championship in Class B was won by Dearborn Heights-Riverside with 73 points, followed by East Grand Rapids with 147 points and Livonia-Clarenceville with 152 points. The First-place winner was Walter McClarren of Dearborn Heights-Riverside with a time of 10:09.0. Robert Crocker of Paw Paw won the Individuals Run with a time of 10:08.8.

Springport High School is the Class C-D Champion for 1965 by compiling a low total of 84 points. Haslett placed second with 126 points and Napoleon placed third with 137 points. Edward Schlosser of Haslett High School finished first in Class C-D with a time of 10:19.1.

At the Upper Peninsula Final Run nine teams were entered in the Class A-B Run. Ishpeming with 31 points placed first for the second consecutive year. Rudyard was second with 87 points. Gene Cyrus of Ishpeming was first-place winner with a time of 10:56.5. In Class C-D, DeTour won the team championship with a score of 48 points followed by Cooks High School with 119 points. Gregory Ledy of DeTour was the

first place finisher with a time of 11:17.4.
