Resurgent Southfield Tracksters Overwhelm Hazel Park, 72-37

Showing team strength that in recent years had become only a memory around the local oval, Southfield's track team surged to an overwhelming 72-37 victory over Southeastern Michigan association rival Hazel Park Monday afternoon.

The Jays were scheduled to go after another dual meet victory this afternoon at 4:15 in a home contest with non-league Highland Park.

The triumph over Hazel Park was a team effort under new coach Chuck Balog, with the Jays notching nine events and tying another on the 13-event card.

IF THERE was a Southfield standout in the balanced performance, it had to be pole-vaulter Bob Maurer, who shattered his own record of last year by vaulting 12-feet, 4-inches for a new school mark in the event.

The only Southfield double-winner was Dave Warford, who topped 5-feet, 7-inches to win the high jump, then came back to nip teammate Dave Eastin at the tape in the 180-yard low hurdles in 21.5-seconds.

Eastin added a first in the high hurdles to his second in the lows, winning the high sticks in 16.5-seconds. Also a 1-2 finisher for the Jays was Ralph Roscoe, who won the broad jump with a leap of 19-feet, 2-inches, and

took second in the 440. Southfield scored the only sweep of the meet when Skip Fournier, Rick Andrews and Kane Boschma finished 1-2-3 in the shot put. Fournier's winning toss was 52-feet, 7-inches.

OTHER Jay first places were registered by Mike Mariconi in the 100 (11 seconds), Jim Mantey in the 220 (24.8 seconds) and Kim Hartman in the 880 (2:05.8).

Hartman, Southfield's top cross-country runner last fall, won the mile in the Jay's last dual meet

against Ferndale teammate Rick Co his 880 victory, th a strong 440 leg t ning mile relay stamp himself pe most versatile run seen on the S track.

Hartman comb Coleman, Kim and Marc Goldste Southfield the m victory in 3:43.4.
