### Carr Sets Record

# Central Trackmen Lose to Kalamazoo

**KALAMAZOO** — Woody Carr set a new school record in the high jump, Arnie Williams scored a double victory in the sprints and Carl English led a sweep of the low hurdles here Thursday afternoon at Loy Norrix Field, but it wasn't enough for Battle Creek as it dropped a 62-47 dual track and field meet decision to Six-A rival Kalamazoo.

Carr boosted his own Battle Creek Central High jump record to six feet, three and one-quarter inches, upsetting Kalamazoo's Fred Carver.

Williams, running into a slight headwind, won the 100-yard dash in :09.9 and 220 in :21.7. A fumbled baton exchange by Bearcat second and third men prevented Williams from anchoring a probable victory in the 880-yard relay.

English, Henry Braddock and Charles Dismuke slammed the low hurdles for Battle Creek, but that was the extent of event victories for Coach Jack Finn's squad, which competed without injured hurdler Larry Evans.

Best marks for Kalamazoo were a city prep record pole vault of 13 feet, one-half inch by Mike Blowers and a shot put of 56 feet, two inches by Ron Thompson.
