Bearcat Trackmen Beat Sexton, 62-47

LANSING — Central High's track team scored its first dual meet victory over Sexton since 1959 here yesterday afternoon by beating the Big Reds over their home track, 62-47.

Woody Carr set a new school high jump mark and Arnie Williams tied his varsity 220-yard dash record as the Bearcats picked up eight first places.

Williams was a double winner by taking the 220 in the record-tying time of 21.5 seconds and preceded that with a win in the century at 9.9 seconds. He also anchored the winning 880-yard relay team to a 1:30.5 clocking. Ben Drain, Carl English and Billy Miller rounded out the quartet.

The only other double winner in the meet was Sexton's Charley Davis who took both hurdles.

Carr cleared six feet, four inches in the high jump to better his previous school mark of 6-3/4. Frank Blake was right behind him to give the Bearcats a second place.

Mike O'Connell won the shot and Ardell Carson took the long jump to give the Bearcats three first places out of four in the field events.

Sylvester Malone again came through in the 880-yard run for team of Bruce Ure, Dean Coy, Malone and John McDonald won the mile relay. The summaries:
