Everett Grabs SC Track Title

EAST LANSING—Lansing Everett High captured its third straight South Central Conference track and field meet here last night under rainy conditions by scoring 64 points.

The Vikings won seven events and placed in all but the long jump. Jackson Parkside took second on 49 points, followed by East Lansing 33, Lakeview 21 and Adrian 20.

Russ Barnes paced Everett on victories in both hurdles, the highs in :14.8 and lows in :20.6. He also ran on the winning 880 relay team. Dave Harder of Adrian also was a double winner, taking the 440 yard dash in :50.5 and the long jump on a new record of 20 feet, 11½ inches.

Aubrey Mullings of East Lansing set a new league mark of 1:59.1 in the half-mile; Rich Ryals of Everett lowered the 220 yard dash record to :22.5, and Fred Schnarr of Everett set the other new standard, a pole vault of 12 feet, 10 inches.

Bob Xaxter led Lakeview on a third spot in the 220, fourth in the 100 and third in the long jump. He also ran on the third place Spartan 880 relay team.
