

Glads Fifth In 'C' Finals

St. Francis Gladiators made their finest showing since beginning track five years ago when they finished in a fifth place in the Class C state track finals at Central Michigan University Saturday.

Battle Creek St. Phillip and Fowlerville tied for first place with 31 points. Portland had 24, Fenaville 21, Kalamazoo University High and St. Francis tied for fifth with 19½ points.

St. Francis picked up their points in a sixth place finish in the 880 yard relay with Vince Fochtman, Bill Mikowski, Doug Smith and Jim Sanborn running the event; and eighth place in the 880 yard run by Jim Brady; a fifth place finish in the 100 by Fochtman and a seventh place in the 220; and a third place finish in the mile relay, run by Bernie Kroupa, Pat Carroll, Jim Brady and Jim Sanborn.

Traverse City's Trojans didn't place in the Class A finals at Michigan State University Saturday. Both Bill Myers and Bob Kortokrax ran the 440 with the former leading at the 220 mark. Myers' leg began to tighten in the stretch and he had to coast in, out of the running. Pole vaulter Dick Wollam cleared the 12 foot mark in his event but went out at the next height.

The Trojans will now prepare for the LMAC meet at Muskegon Catholic Friday night. Coach Jim Ooley felt the running didn't hurt Myers' pulled

muscle, thus increasing the Trojan chances for a high finish in the conference meet.
