

Sage Cracks Mark In Class C Meet

MOUNT PLEASANT (AP) — scored in the annual meet at Fowlerville came from behind in the final event to gain a tie with defending state champion Battle Creek St. Philip for the Class C Michigan high school track title Saturday.
