

## Everett Boasts First All-City Track Crown

Everett won a new crown today as All-City track champion, the first one ever achieved in the school's history.

But as far as the Vikings are concerned it wasn't an easy victory and coach Ben Barr's team was well after exercising an early disappointment and jubilation among conference fans before the triumph.

Everett scored 47 points at East Lansing's Truist Field Monday night and won, which had been the last five All-City crowns, didn't overcome easily. Heading a strong team with 180 points, biggest surprise of the meet was Kalamazoo, which led for more than half the meet and wound up a close third with 46 points.

Last Lansing tallied 291, O'Fallon 13 and Calverton 8 in the final meet.

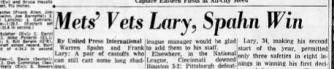
