

Rosenberg Second in Fastest Mile

KALAMAZOO—North Muskegon's Dean Rosenberg and Orchard View's Dennis Popp both gave it the old college try while competing in the 10th annual Champion of Champions track meet.

Rosenberg, the best miler to ever come out of the Muskegon area, finished a spectacular prep career with his fastest time ever, a great 4:19.1, but still had to settle for second place. He was nipped at the wire by Vicksburg's Steve Bishop.

The Norse speedster had pulled away from Jim Giachino of Kalamazoo University High when he was overtaken by Bishop in the last 50 yards. Bishop was clocked at 4:18.7.

Popp set an Orchard View High record in the high hurdles, flashing a time of 15.1 while winning sixth place. Popp was also sixth in the broad jump at 21 feet, 3½ inches. His 20.6 showing in the lows tied his best mark which was a school mark.

Meanwhile, North Muskegon's Dennis Wilder came away from the invitational meet with a fifth in the pole vault.
