

**Delta Meet
Discus Toss
Near-Record**

Ernie Soudek, Austrian Olympian, threw the discus just 16 feet short of the listed world record in a United States Track and Field Federation meet at Delta College here Saturday.

Soudek, who attends the University of Michigan and was representing the Ann Arbor Track Club, got off a toss of 190 feet, 4 inches, the best of his career.

Rob Johnson, former Vassar High star, finished second to Soudek with a throw of 130 feet, 7 inches in his first discus competition.

Johnson, who enrolls this fall at Michigan, beat Soudek in the shot, throwing the 16-pound weight 49 feet, 10 inches. Soudek was second at 48 feet, 6 inches.

Brian Moore of Detroit ran a fine half-mile, covering the 880 yards in 1:58.5. Tom Kearney, state Class A high school mile champion, won his specialty in 4:14.0. Both Moore and Kearney, from Bloomfield Hills, were running for the Redford Track Club.
