

Hill-Dale Team Sets Two Marks

LANSING — The Michigammes, southeastern Michigan cross country team coached by Ken and Betty Simmons of Ann Arbor, easily won their fourth straight meet of the season here during the weekend. Two records were established.

Mickie DeMattia turned in a 13-and-under half-mile time of 2:32 for one of the new marks while Francie Kraker ran the open 1½-mile course in 8:28 for a second record effort.

The Michigammes won both competitive divisions, open and 13-and-under.

Aiding the Michigammes in the 13-and-under division was Linda Bolle, runnerup, while Kathy Kitchenmaster was fifth and Carol Schleede was eighth. Linda Prieskorn was 10th for the visitors.

Ann Arbor's Jane Schulte was third in the open division, won by Francie Kraker, and Michigamme teammates Jane Lee and Susan Dudley were fourth and fifth. Their respective times were 8:46, 9:04 and 9:15.
