

Miss Kraker Chases Record Setter

Ann Arbor's Francie Kraker found herself chasing a world-record setter in the women's half-mile run.

The 18-year-old Michigan freshman, who had run the fastest 880-yard race by an American woman earlier this month, placed fifth in the Maple Leaf Games' 880 at Toronto.

Her time was 2:15.0, off her best of 2:12.8.

The winner was Madelyn Manning, 20-year-old Cleveland girl who was running her first competitive 880. The time of 2:10.2 bettered the world mark of 2:10.5, held by Nagy Szabo of Hungary and Ann Smith of England. Miss Kraker was third in Miss Smith's record race.
