

## Ecorse Takes Class B Crown

EAST LANSING (AP) — Ecorse ran away with the Class B title in the Lansing State Journal-Spartan relays Friday night with great strength in the feature events—the relays.

Ecorse had 23 points, the big ones coming on wins in the spring medley relay and the 880-yard relay.

So what happened to River Rouge?

Rouge had won the event two times in a row but just didn't have the talent this year.

Rouge looked pretty good in the afternoon, running second to Dearborn Riverside in the two-mile relay.

Riverside was an early front runner, soon kicked off.

The scoring was Ecorse 23, Romulus 21, Dexter 13, Mount Clemens Clintondale 12, Dearborn Riverside and Oxford 10, Detroit Lutheran West 9, Fenton 8 and two-time champ River Rouge 7.

Ecorse set a record for the meet in its sprint medley relay. Andy Williams was the fastest of the foursome that did the distance in 2:33.2. This broke the old mark of 2:36.4 by Lansing O'Rafferty last year.

Williams again was the lead-off man in the 880-yard win by Ecorse. It was a good time of 1:36.4, but no record.

There were other good marks set by the pack of more than 1,000 athletes from 71 Class B schools.

Eric Jackson of Mount Clemens Clintondale went six feet 2½ inches in the high jump. The former high was 6-1 held by several others.

Dearborn Riverside was a dark horse. Riverside looked good in the only afternoon relay event — the two-mile — winning in 8:25.0.

This clipped a lot of time off the former record of 8:30.2 by Marshall last year.
