# Gull Lake Wins 3-School Meet

**HICKORY CORNERS** — Chip Ferguson turned on the speed here yesterday to lead Gull Lake High to a triangular track and field meet victory over Pennfield and Mattawan.

Ferguson amassed 16¼ points to pace the Blue Devils to a winning total of 66 points. Pennfield was second with 46½ and Mattawan trailed with 24½.

Ferguson captured the two sprints, taking the 100 in 10.6 seconds and 220 in :23.5, in addition to winning the long jump. He also ran on the winning 880 relay.

Jim Kendrick won the high hurdles and Cliff Harnden the low barriers to provide Gull Lake with two more first spots and teammate Ron Hanson captured the 440.

Tom VanDorsten won the mile run for Pennfield, Dick Phinisey the 880 and Mark Marcus the high jump. Pennfield also captured the mile relay.
