

# Cubs Win Title; Pioneers Trail Ypsilanti High

Saturday's Class A and D state championship track meets will have more than their share of Ann Arbor area high school thinclads following outstanding performances by all four local and area schools represented at the A and B regional meets at Ann Arbor High Saturday.

Winner of the A competition and new regional champion is Ypsilanti High, victor over the host Pioneers in a two-team show that literally went down to the wire.

University High had a far easier time in claiming the D crown with a total of six wins and 71 points in the 13 events.

Providing something of a surprise, however, was the final standing of the area's fourth entrant, Whitmore Lake. The Trojans showed that University High will have a challenge to meet when the two rivals clash in Wednesday's Lakeland C Conference meet.

Jim Millen paced Whitmore Lake to a third-place finish by winning the 180-yard low hurdles and the high jump as the Trojans collected 41½ points behind Litchfield's 55½ points.

While Millen was a double winner for the Trojans, the Cubs' Jim Shipman was the top point-getter in either class as he turned in three victories in the long jump and sprints and also ran the final leg of U High's winning 880-relay.

The Cubs missed victory in the mile relay by less than a second as anchorman George Ging ran his quarter-mile in less than 52 seconds and teammates Mike Procaskey, Jeff Donahey and Gil Mallery gave the Cubs a 3:38.6, only four-fifths of a second over Litchfield's winning time.

Among the many bright notes for the Cubs was the fourth-place in the 880-yard run by Rod Grambeau, running for the first time this year after being sidelined with knee trouble.

While Saturday's results were a source of satisfaction to both University High and the underdog Whitmore Lake squad, disappointment was the ruling mood in the Ann Arbor High camp as the Pioneers lost their bid to repeat last year's regional victory over powerful Ypsilanti.

Chief culprit in demolishing Pioneer ambitions was Kercheval Patterson who staged a repeat of his 1965 performance at Livonia by winning the 100-yard dash and the 220-yard dash, as well as running the final leg of the 880-yard relay which saw the Pioneers edged by a fraction of a second.

Ann Arbor High also lost a

valuable point in the century dash when Pioneer Mike Sims lost the runnerup spot to his brother, Ypsilanti's Oscar Sims, by a razor-thin margin with both sprinters timed at 10.3 seconds.

As expected, Ann Arbor High's Tony Wiench won the shot put with his throw of 58 feet 10 inches, two feet and nine inches better than the best Milford challenge, turned in by Chuck Andrews.

Milford also won third in the shot while a fourth shot putter qualified for the state meet when Wayne Memorial's Barry Binkley threw 54 feet 10 inches, two inches better than the minimum for state meet qualification. In all other events, however, only the top three finishers are eligible for Saturday's state Class A championships at Ferry Field.
