

## Wyandotte Runs First In Regionals

Wyandotte High came up with four firsts, including a double winner in the sprint, to capture the Class A regional track title Saturday at Schafer.

Pete Altshuler won both the 100 and 200 for Wyandotte, being clocked in .101 in the century. Paul Baker ran a 1:57.3 half mile and Al Butcher a 4:23.8 mile for the Bears.

Bob Lynn of Inkster, swept both hurdles while Bill Long of Taylor came with a leap of 21 feet 8 1/2 inches to win the high jump. Wyandotte rolled up 44 points while second place Inkster finished with 21.
