IN TRACK FINALS

Hogan, Aldrich Break Records

John Hogan of North Branch dash in :22.85, Gordie Lee placed fourth in the high jump for New Haven and the 880-yard relay team finished fourth.

Hogan in addition to his record setting performance finished sixth in the long jump with a school record leap of 21-feet, 4 1/4-inches and seventh in the 100-yard dash in a school record time of :10.31. Team mate Doug Monroe placed fifth in the mile run in 4:37.3.


Other area place getters in for Class C were the Frankmunton 880-yard relay team with a seventh place finish, Mayville's Al Cox a second in the 880-yard run in 1:29.1, Les Dale of Marlette fourth in the 880 in 2:00.4, a third in the mile relay by Akron-Fairgrove and Decker-ville's Gavau Phillips second place finish in the pole vault at 12-feet, 2-inches.

Port Huron Catholic High won a third by Ricn Mullins in the 880-yard run and an eighth in the shot put by Tom Noetzel with a distance of 50-5/8. Noetzel scored seven points in Class B competition. Bloomfield Hills Cranbrook took the title with 38 points.

To Smith picked up Marysville High's six points with a third in the pole vault at 12-8. Tom Mann captured Vassar's four points with a fifth in the shot put at 51-feet even. Rick Vincent of Imlay City High finished sixth in the 440-yard dash and the Ladington High 880-yard relay team finished eighth.

In Class D competition North Huron High's Joe Chagnon won the long jump with a distance of 20-feet, 11-inches for his team's eight points. Frank Fierstine of Memphis took a fourth in the 440-yard dash in :53.5. Dale Wissner of Owen-Gage was sixth in the shot put with a heave of 46-8 3/4 and Larry Stoll finished eighth for Unionville in the shot at 46-6. Covert High won Class D team honors with 39 4/5 points.

There were no area finalists in Class A, won by Flint Southwestern with 39 points.
