

Torres Scores Easy Triumph

NEW YORK (AP) — Light heavyweight champion Jose Torres hit tough Wayne Thornton with every punch in the book and scored two first-round knockdowns Saturday night on the way to a lopsided unanimous decision in a rough 15-round title bout.

Thornton broke most of the rules and kept referee Johnny Lo Bianco busy most of the night warning him for his infractions in the first fight ever held in Shea Stadium.

Thornton raked Torres's body with a left-right barrage and left him sagging on the ropes from a right-hand punch in the first round. Thornton, the No. 1 challenger from Fresno, Calif., went down on his back, and

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rolled over. He barely made it up at eight.

The Puerto Rican-born New Yorker swarmed over Thornton and hammered him with both hands. When Wayne retreated to his own corner, unable to defend himself, the referee began to count again. He went all the way for the mandatory eight-count before letting them go at it again.

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A small crowd turned out on a perfect night for the first outdoor fight in New York since Floyd Patterson and Ingemar Johanson in 1960.

Although Torres never again dropped Thornton he raked him mercilessly in the eighth and drove home nine straight punches in the ninth.

The champ fought in spurts, when ever he could get his left hand loose from Thornton who tried to hold that dangerous weapon all night long.

Thornton wrestled, held, heeled, hit low and used his shoulder on Torres but never did any serious damage. At one stage in the eighth round after Torres landed a heavy series of blows, Wayne stuck out his tongue at the champ.

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When Wayne cuffed Torres in the 13th, the champ merely laughed at him. Several times during the fight, Torres shook his head as though in disgust.

Lo Bianco was the busiest man in the ring, tugging at the 174-pound Thornton and the 175-pound Torres. He almost needed a crow bar to break Wayne's grip on that left hand. Once the referee had to warn Thornton to watch his language.

Referee Lo Bianco scored it 12-2-1 and each judge, Artie Adala and Al Berl, had it 10-4-1. The AP card for Torres was a lopsided 13-2.

Fenton Eighth In 'B' Track

EAST LANSING — Don Madden, Ron Wardie and Darrell Van Dusen set school records in the state Class B track championships Saturday at Young Field.

Fenton scored 14 1/2 points to finish eighth. Unbeaten Bloomfield Hills Cranbrook which picked up important points with firsts in the 880 relay and 100 to win the title with 38 points. Escorse had 36 1/2.

Although the Flint area failed to produce an individual champion, Madden ran the quarter mile in 50.7 to break his school record for the second time in two weeks.

Teammate Wardie also lowered his Fenton mark when he turned in a 1:59.8 effort in the 880. Wardie and Madden finished fifth.

Van Dusen, the regional and County B League 100 and 220 champion, set a Durand 220 record in 22.4, placing third, and had his best 100 showing (10.3) for a fifth.

Corunna's Gary Harris failed to qualify in the low hurdles finals but placed third in the high jump and fifth in the high hurdles.

Fenton's 880 relay team of Madden, Don Foltz, Chuck Koan and Wardie finished sixth, also in Fenton record time of 3:30.4. Koan added an eighth in the 440 (51.7).

Ron Strang of Detroit Lutheran won the mile run in 4:21.1, bettering the former B record of 4:22.3 by Eric Zempen of Howell, in 1962.

The winning pole vault height of 13 feet, 6 inches by Bill Bekkering of Fremont just topped the Class B former high of 13-13 1/2 by Ernest Van Hage of Hudsonville Christian in 1964.

Dearborn Heights Riverside, winning the mile relay in 3:25.1, bettered the former B record of 3:26.3 by River Rouge in 1964.
